



Membership Eligibility

Any person who holds an executive, managerial or professional position on a substantially full-time basis in one of the qualified fields of or services related to commercial real estate may become a member of CREW Pittsburgh. Applicants shall submit a written application, and two sponsorship signatures from active members. For purposes of the foregoing, the term "commercial real estate" shall mean income producing real property and real property held for investment. In addition, new provisions have been made to include civic, retired, and student membership options, as well as vendor memberships for those who support the field of commercial real estate. Further details and membership dues can be found on the application. The annual membership fee includes both local and national dues.

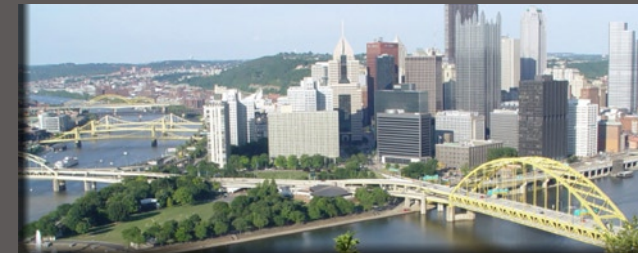

The Foundation & History

In October 1994, five (5) women in Pittsburgh worked diligently to form a women's organization in the field of commercial real estate.

In 1995, Pittsburgh Women in Commercial Real Estate (PWCRE) was formed. Using everyone's Rolodex information, the first meeting was held in February 1995 at the Duquesne Club with an overwhelming 80 women present.

After that, PWCRE attracted an average 100 members per year.

In 2002, the Board of Directors evaluated the possibility of expanding the scope of the organization by joining forces with the national network of Commercial Real Estate Women — CREW Network.

Based on positive membership feedback a formal vote was conducted in June 2002, the result of which was an overwhelming majority voting to become the Western Pennsylvania chapter of CREW Network.

In October of 2002, PWCRE was officially voted into the national network. The name was changed in 2004 to CREW Pittsburgh.
